



# Flight Information File 2009-04

**SUBJECT:** Operations at out station airports – TSA concerns

**DATE:** July 9, 2009

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has issued a revision to its commercial airport Security Directive 1542-04-08G (SD-8G) that addresses transient pilot operations at affected airports. The changes now contained in SD-8G, in part state:

“For transient pilots, they will not be required to have airport badges or background checks from any of the non Home-Based airports they visit. Transient pilots are advised to remain in the footprint of their aircraft and to and from fixed-based operator, service provider or airport exit. Special allowance will be given to transient pilot operators in the AOA (Airport Operations Area) who are fueling or in emergency status.”

This change requires the transient pilot at affected airports to avoid unnecessary movement on the airport and to proceed directly to and from their aircraft and the FBO. There are over 450 airports affected by this security directive. The following WMU approved airports that are currently affected by this security directive are listed below.
