American Airlines offers a limited number of paid positions in the internship. **These positions are located in Dallas-Fort Worth only.** You may receive college credit; hourly pay is \$9.00 with a Monday to Friday work week at 40 hours a week.

Additionally, you may have domestic travel (weekends), scheduled simulator time, Computer Based Trainers, and the opportunity to see how one of the largest airlines in the world operates.

At completion of the internship you will have the opportunity for three standby round trip travel passes (all service charges, taxes and fees apply.)

Decisions

American Airlines will notify you of your acceptance into the internship program within two or three weeks of the interview. At that time, you will be provided with your beginning and ending dates along with other information you may need.

Un Paid Internship:

Many of the internships that American Airlines offers are un-paid positions in the internship. **These positions are located in Dallas-Fort Worth, Chicago, Los Angeles, New York and Miami.** You may receive college credit; and a Monday through Thursday work week.

Additionally, you may have domestic travel (weekends), scheduled simulator time, Computer Based Trainers, 2 day International Ground School training, tour of Boeing Facility in Seattle, other scheduled tours and the opportunity to see how one of the largest airlines in the world operates.

At completion of the internship you will have the opportunity for three standby round trip travel passes (all service charges, taxes and fees apply.)

Prior to applying, be sure you are able to handle the financial aspect of the internship. Just to give you some idea of what it will cost to live in Dallas/Forth Worth, average rent for a one-bedroom or studio will run anywhere from \$600-\$800 per month, depending on location and furnishings.
