Founded in 1966, Seacamp offers marine science education and summer camp experiences including SCUBA, sailing, board sailing, and arts & crafts to students from 12-17 years of age. **SCIENCE INSTRUCTOR OPENINGS:** Course topics include marine biology, coral reef ecology, ichthyology, animal behavior, invertebrate biology, shark biology, fisheries science, environmental science, marine aquaria, and marine research. Courses taught in local habitats which include mangroves, coral reefs, tide pools, and shallow marine ecosystems. Each course provides lab work, lecture, and field trips by boats and vans. Participate in all camp functions and assist camp supervisor as assigned.

**REQUIREMENTS:** At least 21 years old with a Bachelor's Degree in Science or related field experience and have an interest in teaching teens about the environment in a tropical residential camp setting. Valid driver's license with an excellent driving record. Must be comfortable in the water with strong boating and aquatic skills. SCUBA is preferred but not required. Employment dates are May 23-August 31; May 23-December 20; or year-round.
