Scholarship Application

Award is presented annually to a student member of ASCE who has made a contribution to the advancement of student engineering activities. This award will consist of a one-time grant of \$1,000, and considers academic performance as an indication of preparation for future career in Civil Engineering.

Eligibility and Requirements

All applicants must:

- Be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing in at Western Michigan University in the Department of Civil or Construction Engineering.
- Have a cumulative grade-point average of 2.5 at the time of application.
- Attach an official college transcript.
- Submit a current ASCE Scholarship Application (photocopies are accepted).

Selection Process

Initial judging will be made on the basis of each candidate's academic record, participation in extra-curricular activities, evidence of leadership, character, and self-reliance, comments from employers and university officials, and financial need. Semi-finalists may be contacted for an interview .

The scholarship committee reserves the right to use discretion in the award of the available scholarships, and all decisions of the scholarship committee are final.

Deadlines

Completed applications must be submitted to the Western Michigan University ASCE Student Chapter Faculty Advisor by October 30, 2006. Awards will be announced in February.
