**Position:** Non-tenure Track, Assistant Professor Position in Educational Leadership, Research, and Technology at Western Michigan University in Kalamazoo, Michigan, beginning 2009-2010 academic year.

**Qualifications:** Earned doctorate in education, or related field prior to January 1, 2010, with demonstrated scholarly accomplishments or the potential for such in the area of educational technology/distance learning. Candidates with prior university teaching experience will be given priority, previous experience as a K-12 teacher or administrator is desirable. Applicants should be knowledgeable and demonstrate prior successful experiences in the support/integration of technology into K-12 schools, and can demonstrate success with working with diverse populations.

**Duties:** The successful candidate will teach graduate and undergraduate courses in educational technology on campus and on-line, and will provide academic advising for graduate students. This position also includes curriculum development; maintaining relationships with university technology support services, and other regional campuses of the Extended University Programs.

**University:** Western Michigan University is a Carnegie Doctoral I public university, the fourth largest in Michigan. The Carnegie foundation for the Advancement of Teaching has placed WMU among the 76 public institutions in the nation designated as research universities with high research activity. Approximately 25,000 students are currently enrolled in a metropolitan community of 250,000.
