

What requirements must I meet in order to graduate with a Bachelors' Degree?

- To receive a bachelors' degree from WMU, you will complete all General Education requirements plus at least one major and one minor.
- Some students have multiple majors and/or minors.
- Some majors require specific minors.
- Additionally, some programs have additional requirements. Your college (curriculum) advisor will answer your questions, help you choose the best courses for you, and ensure that you are on track toward successful completion of a degree from WMU.
- As you select a major and minor, you will meet with faculty advisors within the departments/schools offering your chosen major and minor. Your faculty advisors will complete your major and minor slips, and will help you to plan the sequence of courses required in your area.
- Many courses do have prerequisites, so careful planning is important.
- College (curriculum) Advisors assist you in working to meet all university requirements.
- Your Faculty Advisors provide assistance with the specific requirements in your major and minor.
- Both play an important role and have a depth of knowledge to share with you. Together they will ensure that you make the most of the opportunities available to you at WMU!
