

Can I take any course “credit/no credit”?

- You may elect for "Credit/No Credit" any course approved for General Education or General Physical Education credit, as well as other courses not counting toward your major or specified in your curriculum as defined in the University Undergraduate Catalog.
- **Courses required for a major or minor cannot be taken for credit/no credit.**
- It's a good idea to check with your advisor if you have a question on this.
- Here are some parameters to consider:
 - Credit will be given for a grade of 'C' or better in a course taken for credit/no credit.
 - No credit will be given for any grade below a 'C' in a course taken for credit/no credit.
 - Your instructor will not know whether or not you have registered for the course on a credit/no credit basis or for a letter grade.
 - You may change from a letter grade status to credit/no credit, or from credit/no credit to a letter grade only during the drop/add period of the semester or session.
- **Com 4990 is offered only as a credit/no credit. Letter grades are not an option.**
