

What happens if I repeat a course?

- The most recent grade for a repeated course is used in calculating your GPA at Western.
- However if you receive a letter grade in a course and then take the course over and receive a grade of 'W', 'Credit', or 'No credit', the previously earned grade will remain in your GPA.
- In most instances the number of times a course can be repeated is limited to three, although grades of 'W', 'Credit', or 'No credit' are not counted as attempts.
- **Communication/Journalism courses can be repeated twice, including "W" and "X"**. Please note this is different than the general university policy.
- Also be aware that a repeated course will not be removed from your transcript. All grades earned are shown on your transcript from WMU.
