Section E: Communication Electives 9 hours

Nine hours of electives in Communication, six of which may be selected from any courses offered by the school and three hours selected from upper-level (3000 or higher) courses in the school.

- All course prerequisites must be met to enroll in upper-level courses.
- A course and its prerequisite cannot be taken at the same time.
- Grade requirement: A minimum grade of "C" is required in all courses to be applied toward the major.
- The School prohibits students from taking a class more than twice for credit.
- Baccalaureate-level writing requirement must be met by taking one of the courses marked with an asterisk (*).
- ** Students may take up to 6 hours of COM 3050 credit **provided the topics are different.**
- Up to six hours of COM 4990/3980 may be used as electives in the major.
- Courses outside the school may be used with prior written permission of the School of Communication Advisor.
