

## Information to Journalism Majors re: Liberal Arts Supplement

The journalism major requires a minimum of 65 credit hours in the College of Arts and Sciences not including courses in journalism or mass communication. These 65 credits must include at least one course in American literature, at least one in history, and one in political science. This list below explains what course may and may not be counted toward this 65-hour requirement.
