# Haworth College of Business Fast Facts

- Western Michigan University's Haworth College of Business enjoys an outstanding reputation, with several nationally ranked programs at both the graduate and undergraduate levels.
- The College has one of the largest undergraduate programs in the country, with an enrollment of nearly 4,000.
- The College holds the distinction of being one of just 500 among the 1,800 business schools in the nation with undergraduate and graduate programs that are accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business.
- In 2008, the College opened a dedicated Career Services Center in Schneider Hall, providing students with career search resources and facilitating communication among students and potential employers.
- The College regularly hosts local, national and international conferences for students, faculty and business leaders to share and exchange information and ideas. The College regularly hosts the annual Food Marketing Conference and the annual Information Technology Forum.
- Interdisciplinary programs, such as Telecommunications & Information Management, and Integrated Supply Management, provide unique educational opportunities by integrating courses from other disciplines such as engineering and communications.
- The College has the largest computer information systems program in the State of Michigan, and is the only one that offers three information technology majors -- Computer Information Systems, Telecommunications & Information Management, and e-Business Design.
- The Accountancy major fulfills the 150+ requirement for taking the CPA exam. In addition, undergraduate students may take some of these courses at the graduate level, earning credit toward an MSA.
- In 2009, the College celebrated the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the nationally renowned Food & Consumer Package Goods program.
- The Personal Financial Planning major is approved by the Certified Financial Planner's Board of Standards to meet the education requirement for taking the CFP certification examination.
- Students from all business disciplines regularly participate in local, regional, national and international events and competitions, testing knowledge, networking with students from around the world and enhancing the College's reputation for quality education.
