On Tues., April 15, senior engineering conference features 72 projects

The 42nd Conference on Senior Engineering Design Projects – set for Tues., April 15 – features 72 projects presented by 194 seniors who represent programs in seven CEAS departments. The event is free and open to the public. Free parking is available.

The 25-minute presentations begin exactly on the hour and half hour between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. at the Parkview Campus. No projects will be presented during the lunch break from 12 to 1 p.m. Here is an overview of the CEAS departments' projects with the **start times** of the first and the last project presentations:

Civil and Construction Engineering (CCE): 25 students offer 8 projects - 9 to 1:30 in D-115.

Computer Science (CS): 12 students present 5 projects - 10 to 1 in D-210.

Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE): 17 students plan 5 projects - 9 to 11 in D-202.

Industrial Design (ID): 19 students offer 11 projects - 9 to 3:30 in D-109.

Industrial and Manufacturing Engineering (IME): 36 students present 11 projects - 8 to 2 in D-201.

Paper Engineering, Chemical Engineering, and Imaging (PCI): 26 students offer 8 projects - 9 to 2:30 in D-208.
