- the reasons you are applying for a scholarship
- what was most beneficial to you in your educational experience and why
- any other information that you believe would be helpful to the Committee in making its decision

If you are a transfer student, please attach a copy of your credit evaluations to this application. Your WMU records are available to us through the University database.

TYPES OF AWARDS

These awards are usually based solely on a student's need factor. Grade point average must reflect good standing within the University. Applicant must be displaying progress toward graduation. If you are applying on the basis of *need*, please so indicate on your application and biographical information.

3. HAWORTH COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

These awards are funded by alumni donations. Awards are based on College achievement and extracurricular activities within the College and University.
