



## Bankruptcy Notice

According to information we received from the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS), you have federal loans in active bankruptcy status and are ineligible to receive federal or state financial aid funds unless specific conditions are met.

You would be eligible for financial aid if your loans are considered “dischargeable.” The holder of your loan has complete discretion to determine whether the loan is considered dischargeable. You must obtain and submit documentation from the holder of the loan stating your loans in active bankruptcy are dischargeable. **Your documentation must be received in our office at least 30 days prior to your last date of enrollment for the academic year you are requesting financial aid.** To determine the holder of your loans, you may access the NSLDS Web Site at [www.nsls.ed.gov](http://www.nsls.ed.gov) and click on “Financial Aid Review.” If you do not have a PIN, you can click on “PIN Home” in the “Financial Aid Review” section to request one.

We encourage you to resolve this issue as quickly as possible. Many financial aid programs have specific deadlines. Delays in processing your application may result in a reduction or loss of financial aid awards. Be sure to include your name and WIN number on any documents you submit.
