



- \$6,000 per year
- Awarded in equal amounts, fall and spring only
- Need-based
- Renewable
- Michigan residents who are TIP eligible
- Enroll for fall term immediately after high school graduation

The Bronco First Scholarship is available to Michigan residents who are eligible for the State of Michigan's Tuition Incentive Program (TIP). This is a need-based award that covers undergraduate tuition. Michigan TIP is awarded when a student has successfully completed 56 credit hours.

Interested students need to send a copy of their TIP award letter to Student Financial Aid. For more information about this scholarship, please contact the **Office of Admissions, (269) 387-2000.**

#### **The criteria for selection include:**

- First-time, undergraduate degree-seeking student, entering WMU for fall 2009
- Complete admission application file (application, high school transcript, ACT/SAT scores and application fee) received in the Office of Admissions
- Admissible to WMU
- Must send a copy of TIP award letter to:

- **Must complete FAFSA by March 1**
- Must live in residence halls

The Bronco First Scholarship can be renewed in consecutive semesters up to a total of eight semesters, or until graduation requirements are met, whichever occurs first.

#### **Criteria for renewal include:**

- Continue to demonstrate financial need and file a FAFSA by March 1 every year
- Continue to enroll at WMU as a full-time student
- Make Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Successfully complete 24 credit hours each academic year
- Continue to live in residence halls
