



- \$6,000 per year
- Paid in equal amounts fall and spring semesters
- Pays non-resident tuition only; not ATIS (online) or EUP
- For non-Michigan, U.S. residents
- Merit-based
- Renewable
- Enroll fall term immediately after high school graduation

The Provost Scholarship is a merit-based award available to non-Michigan residents who meet the selection criteria. The Office of Admissions automatically considers all entering freshmen for this scholarship; no additional application is required.

Interested students must apply for admission to WMU by May 1, 2009.

Criteria for selection include:

The criteria for selection include:

- First-time, domestic, undergraduate degree seeking student, entering WMU for fall 2009
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- ACT composite score of 22 or higher OR a SAT combined score (math + critical reading) of 1020 or higher
- Complete admission application file (application, high school transcript, ACT or SAT score(s), and application fee) received in the Office of Admissions by **May 1, 2009**

The Provost Scholarship can be awarded up to a total of eight consecutive semesters, or until graduation requirements are met, whichever occurs first.

Criteria for renewal include:

- Maintain a cumulative WMU GPA of 2.5
- Successfully complete 24 credit hours each academic year
- Continue to enroll at WMU as a full-time student
- Remain a non-Michigan resident

Students who are eligible for more than one scholarship for first-time students will be awarded the one of highest value.
