

# Provost Scholarship



The Office of Admissions will automatically consider all entering freshmen for this scholarship, so there is no additional application. The Provost Scholarship is based on full-time enrollment of at least 12 credit hours per semester. To be eligible, you must enroll the fall term immediately following high school graduation.

## **The Provost Scholarship** **A scholarship for first-time students**

- ◆ **For non-Michigan US residents**
- ◆ **Merit-based**
- ◆ **Renewable**

The Provost Scholarship is open to non-Michigan US residents only. This merit-based award is renewable for eight consecutive semesters, or until graduation requirements are met -- whichever occurs first. The Office of Admissions will automatically consider entering freshmen for this award, so no additional application is necessary. Awards will be made as long as funds are available. The criteria for selection include:

- First-time, domestic, undergraduate degree seeking student, entering WMU for fall 2008
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- ACT composite score of 22 or higher, or a combined score (math + critical reading) of 1020 on the SAT

## **The Award**

- ◆ **\$6,000 per year**
- ◆ **Split evenly between fall and spring only**

- Complete admission application file (application, high school transcript, ACT or SAT score(s), and application fee) received in the Office of Admissions

Once a student has been awarded the Provost Scholarship, certain maintenance criteria must be met in order to renew the award.

- You must maintain a GPA of 3.0
- You must successfully complete 24 credit hours fall and spring
- You must remain a non-resident

The award will be paid in equal amounts in fall and spring semesters. Students who are eligible for more than one scholarship for first-time students will be awarded the one of the highest value.
