



- \$3,000 or \$6,000
- Paid in equal amounts, fall and spring only
- Early deadline
- Nonrenewable
- Merit-based
- Enroll fall term immediately after high school graduation
- Must enroll in 12 credit hours each fall and spring semester

This award is given to students who participate in the Medallion Scholarship competition, but do not receive a Medallion Scholarship. The Office of Admissions will automatically consider all entering freshmen for this scholarship and invite all eligible students to the Medallion Scholarship Competition on Jan. 21 or Jan. 28, 2012. No additional application is required. Interested students must apply for admission to WMU by Dec. 2, 2011.

#### Criteria for selection include:

- First-time, domestic, undergraduate degree seeking student, entering WMU fall 2012
- 3.7 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale at the end of the junior year
- ACT composite score of 26 or higher OR a SAT combined score (math + critical reading) of 1170 or higher
- Complete admission application file (application, high school transcript, ACT/SAT scores and application fee) received in the Office of Admissions by **Dec. 2, 2011**
- Must be admissible to WMU
- Students who participate in the Medallion Scholarship Competition who are not awarded a Medallion Scholarship will receive one of the following Dean's Scholarships:
  - \$6,000 total over two years (Medallion finalists – minimum of 20 awards)
  - \$3,000 for one year (all remaining competitors)
- Dean's scholarship recipients who live in the residence halls in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 academic years will be awarded a \$4,000 Residence Hall Award for the 2013-14 academic year.

Students who are eligible for more than one scholarship for first-time students will be awarded the one of highest value.
