

Academic Standards and Progression

To achieve satisfactory academic progress in the Physician Assistant Program the student must maintain an aggregate grade of B (GPA of 3.00). The PA Program considers a grade below C in any of the medical science courses to represent unsatisfactory academic progress. Unsatisfactory academic progress will result in an academic board review and may result in repeating course work, academic probation, or dismissal from the Program. Academic progress in the second year is evaluated by end of rotation exams, preceptor evaluations, and other course work requirements. Students must maintain an average grade of at least 82% on rotation exams and preceptor evaluations must be scored as “satisfactory” or “honors.”
