

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE HONORS PROGRAM OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND
THE LEE HONORS COLLEGE OF WESTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY**

The Honors Program of Community College (CC) and the Lee Honors College (LHC) of Western Michigan University (WMU) hereby enter into an agreement concerning honors students at Community College who wish to continue their honors education at WMU. Provisions of the agreement include:

1. All CC students wishing to continue their Honors work at WMU must first be admitted to the University.
2. Following admission to the University, students who have received the Community College Honors Certificate or equivalent, and who maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher will automatically be admitted to the Lee Honors College. Students who have not received the Honors Certificate or equivalent, but who have taken at least 9 credit hours in the CC Honors Program and have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher will also be automatically admitted to the LHC.
3. Following admission to the LHC, all students will consult with the dean, the associate dean, or the academic advisor of the LHC to establish an appropriate course of study in the honors college leading to graduation from WMU and the LHC.
4. Both programs will notify each other concerning contemplated curricular changes that would affect this agreement.
5. This agreement will continue for five years and will then be renewed or revised as necessary by mutual agreement.
