Dear Prospective Applicant,

The U.S. Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista is a year round, warm weather facility in Southern California. The Training Center is a 150-acre complex adjacent to Lower Otay Lake in San Diego County. The Center has sport venues and support facilities for nine Olympic sports: archery, canoe/kayak, cycling, field hockey, rowing, soccer, softball, tennis, and track and field.

The United States Olympic Committee conducts an internship program for college students that follow the traditional college semesters fall, winter/spring and summer. To be eligible students must have completed at least 2 years of college and be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program in an accredited United States college or university.

Within the Coaching and Sport Science Division, the Physiology Department offers a rewarding internship experience focused on applied physiology and optimization of training in elite athletes. This internship offers a unique opportunity to gain experience working with high caliber athletes. The primary responsibilities of the physiology intern are to assist in data collection, reduction and presentation. Other secondary duties may include: data processing, literature research, equipment maintenance and other duties as assigned.

The typical work schedule is: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Interns are provided with housing at the Training Center and eat their meals at the Athlete's Dining Hall. A small stipend is also provided.
