1873 3 June	Perkins Sale: The Perkins Library. Sold by Auction - Gadsden, Ellis & Co. (Includes illuminated Manuscripts, ancient Bibles, printing on vellum, and the four folio editions of Shakespeare.)
1932 27- 28 Jan.	The Lothian Collection: Illuminated Mss., Incunabula & Americana. Sold by Auction - American Art Association, Anderson GalleriesInc. (Including The Blickling Homilies, The Tikytt Psalter, and a copy of The Nuremberg Chronicle bound with Albrecht Dürer's Apocalypse.)
