The **Virtuoso Horn Duo**, Kerry Turner and Kristina Mascher, began performing in 2002. Based in Luxemburg, the Duo has traveled extensively, giving concerts to enthusiastic audiences at the Britain in Luxembourg Exhibition, the University of Prague, the International Horn Symposium in Valencia, Spain, the 2nd Australian Brass Festival in Melbourne, Australia, the Academy of Music in Singapore, the Festival of Nations in Rome, at AIR Horns in Arizona (USA) and in Chemnitz, Germany. They offer a program of highly melodic, sometimes traditional and often technically dazzling horn playing, combined with world class artistry and execution. In 2006 the Virtuoso Horn Duo recorded a CD of concertos for two horns and chamber orchestra with the Sinfonietta Cracovia for the MSR Classics label.

As part of its 2009 tour, the Duo is performing at universities across the United States with highly acclaimed tubist Kyle Turner and pianist Laretta Bloomer. In addition to being principal tubist with the American Symphony and the Orchestra of St. Luke's, Kyle Turner is the number one freelance tuba player in the City of New York. He has performed with the Metropolitan Opera, the New York City Ballet Orchestra, the New York City Opera Orchestra, Orpheus, the American Composers Orchestra, the New York Philharmonic Brass Quintet, Canadian Brass, Harmonic Brass of Munich, Solid Brass, the American Horn Quartet, the Radio City Music Hall Orchestra, a number of Broadway show orchestras, and many others. He performed in over 500 concerts with the New York Philharmonic as interim principal from 2001–04. Mr. Turner teaches privately and at Montclair State University in New Jersey.
