Regalia not picked up by 5 p.m. on Friday will be taken to the Green Room of Shaw Theatre on Saturday morning, December 19, by 8 a.m. Regalia may be left at the York Arena Theatre of Shaw Theatre after the ceremony. (Regalia not returned will be billed directly to you at replacement costs--approximately \$200.)
