Drop/Add Policy

The official registration drop/add period extends five business days into a session. In addition, a 24-hour grace period will be provided to students who drop or add a course that meets for the first time on or after the final day of the drop/add period (late fees may apply).

Instructors are not obligated to update students who add a course after the first class meeting. Students are responsible for obtaining the work missed.

Refund Policy

Official Registration drop/add period for Summer I, 2003

The University Business Office will grant refunds for student tuition for any decrease in hours according to this schedule:

May 9 100%
Complete Withdrawal (withdraw from all courses). Refunds are awarded as follows:
May 10-16, 2003 50%
May 17-June 2, 2003..... 25%
There will be no refunds awarded for complete withdrawals after June 2, 2003

Official Registration drop/add period for Summer II, 2003

The University Business Office will grant refunds for student tuition for any decrease in hours according to this schedule:

July 2..... 100%
Complete Withdrawal (withdraw from all courses). Refunds are awarded as follows:
July 3-8, 2003..... 50%
July 9-21, 2003..... 25%
There will be no refunds awarded for complete withdrawals after July 21, 2003
