Bonn University, Germany

The WMU program at Bonn University offers qualified students the opportunity to live and study in Germany. Their studies are accompanied by intensive German language training in classes offered by the Akademische Auslandsamt (International Programs Office). Unique Features: Bonn University (Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms- Universität Bonn) was founded in 1818. Almost 70 years of tradition and experience go into the University of Bonn's immersion study abroad program. Students may expect to be supported by the full range of student services including academic guidance, intercultural experience, counseling, and registration assistance. The university's language proficiency requirement for international students is lowered for program students. They can profit from the pro-gram's flexible character by choosing from language and topical classes for international program students as well as from the full course catalogue of the University. During the semester the International Office offers an extensive cultural program as well as various other programs to ensure cultural immersion. Students are advised by the WMU faculty program director and a member of the regular WMU German language and area studies faculty. The faculty director is present during students' first week in Bonn and is available for advising. WMU students at Bonn University have the same privileges and responsibilities as all students and access to university buildings and services.
