
## File Share Access on a Mac (On- Campus) Method 1 – NoMAD


Step 1: If you are not signed into NoMAD on your computer you will have to sign into the NoMAD window that pops up on your screen.



Step 2: Otherwise, you should be logged in after signing into your computer and should see a triangle icon in the top bar of your computer screen.



Click on this icon to bring up the NoMAD menu and hover over the Share Drives menu item. This will show you your departmental share drive, your share drive if you are a part of any grants, and your personal share drive.



Clicking on any of those three options will automatically connect you to that share drive. Repeat the process for any of the other share drives you would like to access.

## Method 2 – Share Drive Shortcut:

On some older versions of MacOS (10.14 - Mojave and earlier) there is a ahortcut that can be placed on your desktop that will allow you to mount all of your shared drives by double clicking on it.




If you do not have this icon on your desktop then it can be acquired by following these steps:


- 1. Proceed to Method 3 of these instructions and follow along until you can connect to your department share drive.
- 2. Navigate through the folders as follows:
  - a. COAS -> ComputerFixes -> Apple
- 3. Copy the file pertaining to your installation of MacOS to your desktop
- 4. To test to make sure that it works double click on it and see if your shared drives properly show up.

## Method 3 – Manual Connections:

Step 1: On the Finder Menu, Click on GO and Then Click on Connect to server



Step 2: In the Server Address type in the following: smb://cas-wfp0.wade.wmich.edu/deptshares\$ Click the + sign Click Connect



Step 3: On the Login Window Enter Your Bronco Net ID and Password. Check Remember this password in my Keychain and click connect.



Now you will be able to access the department Share on the server.

To access your Home directory repeat the above steps with the following changes: In step 2: In the Server Address type in the following: <a href="mailto:smb://cas-wfp0.wade.wmich.edu/usershares\$/your BroncoNET ID">smb://cas-wfp0.wade.wmich.edu/usershares\$/your BroncoNET ID</a> Click the + sign Click Connect

Once you complete the steps you should be able to access your home Directory on the server.
