### Requirements (18 credit hours)

1. In consultation with the department advisor, select focus area that meets your intellectual needs and interest.
2. Select up to **two (2) courses** from major area of study towards credit for minor
3. **Mandatory Courses:**
  - LWIR 3000: Immigration, Race, and Ethnic Relations in the United States
  - LWIR 4000: Research in Race and Ethnic Relations
4. 12 credits from approved list related to focus area, or different course with consent of the director.
5. Complete 18 credit hours with a "C" or better in each course from at least two (2) different departments. In addition to LWIR 4000, **a least one (1) additional course must be at the 4000 level or higher.**
