The CMS team has been busy, too

- Webforms
 - Spam detection
 - Flood control by default
 - Field-based recipients
 - Conditional fields
- Supplemental information field moved to main column
- Directory pages
 - Contact forms replaced mailto: links
 - Student contributor access
- YouTube support added to media manager

- New roles and moderation system

Current moderation problems

- Strict contributor→editor hierarchy is difficult for small teams
- Rules for which roles can be combined are inflexible
- Editors can override contributors' changes without review
- Complicated workflow to add new pages

New roles

Author

- Create and edit **basic pages**
- Create and edit **directory pages**
- Mark drafts as “**needs review**”

Publisher

- Publish pages marked “needs review”
- Remove “needs review” status to request further changes
- Responsible for writing style and standards-compliance

Reporter

- Create and edit own **news articles**
- Create and edit own **events**
- Mark drafts as “needs review” to **submit to WMU News**

Manager

- Create, edit and place **spotlights, social media badges, slideshows, directory lists** and **webforms**
- Create, edit and delete **menu links** using the “manage section menus” screen

Moderation rules

- Publishers cannot publish their own changes
- Roles can be assigned in any combination
- All sections must have at least two users
- All sections must have at least one publisher and one manager (can be the same person)
- Sections encouraged to have at least one reporter—not required
- Student employees may only be authors, except by approval

How will the old roles convert?

- Contributor → Author + reporter
- Editor → Author + publisher
- Section manager → Manager
- News contributor → Reporter
- Student contributor → Author

Known bugs

- File attachments not deleted
- WYSIWYG pop-ups are shrunk in Chrome
- Spotlight images disappear when editing limit/exclude
- Apostrophes display as ' in browser page title
- Revert, unpublish and moderation history may not be accessible
- Text wraps on directory lists in IE8
- Captions don't work with YouTube videos in Firefox, IE
- Cut, copy and paste buttons may produce an error in Firefox
- Table captions may not allow spaces in Chrome
- Spellcheck doesn't toggle in IE10
- Webform results are not accessible
