Costs and Fees, Summer 2008

The Third Coast Writing Project is committed to ensuring that our programs are financially accessible for all teachers. Below is a summary of fees and costs for our Summer 2008 programs for teachers. TCWP registration fees pay for leadership, supplies, tuition subsidies, and other program expenses.

2008 TCWP INVITATIONAL SUMMER INSTITUTE (ISI)

Educators invited to participate in TCWP's flagship program as ISI summer fellows pay a \$350 registration fee and receive 4 hours of WMU graduate credit at no additional cost.

4 Graduate Credit Option: No additional cost *

"Plus Two" Option: 2 additional graduate credits at regular university rates = \$689.50

A NOTE: TCWP directly subsidizes 4 WMU graduate credits for all Invitational Summer Institute participants. At current WMU tuition rates, this equals a tuition grant of over \$1000.00 per participant.

TEACHER AS WRITER WORKSHOP (TAW)

TAW participants pay a \$350 registration fee.

WMU Graduate Credit Option: 2 credits – additional charge = \$430.25 **

SB-CEU Option: 5 CEUs – additional charge = \$75.00

IMPROVING THINKING & COMPREHENSION WORKSHOP (ITC)

ITC participants pay a \$350 registration fee.

WMU Graduate Credit Option: 2 credits – additional charge = \$430.25 **

SB-CEU Option: 4 CEUs – additional charge = \$60.00

DIGITAL STORYTELLING WORKSHOP (DS)

DS participants pay a \$350 fee.

WMU Graduate Credit Option: 2 credits – additional charge = \$430.25 **

SB-CEU Option: 4 CEUs – additional charge = \$60.00

ELL CONNECTED MINI-INSTITUTE (ELL)

ELL participants pay a \$300 fee; they also participate in 2 follow-up meetings during the academic year. (Credit is awarded either fall 2008 or spring 2009 semester.)

WMU Graduate Credit Option: 2 credits – additional charge = \$480.25 **

SB-CEU Option: 3 CEUs – additional charge = \$45.00

* Fees fully subsidized by TCWP

** Fees partially subsidized by TCWP

TWO IMPORTANT NOTES:

- All SB-CEU credits are *estimated* until formally approved by the Western Michigan University Office of Lifelong Learning and Education.
