# Keio University (Tokyo, Japan)

Keio University is a private, co-educational university and the oldest institution of higher education in Japan. It is also one of the most prestigious institutions of higher learning in the nation. The various campuses include Mita, Shinannomachi, Hiyoshi, Yagami, and Shonan Fujisawa; students studying on this exchange program attend the Hiyoshi and Mita campuses. The Mita campus--the university's main campus since 1873--is located in Tokyo with an enrollment of more than 11,000 undergraduate and graduate students. The Mita campus is a 10minute walk from Tamachi Station. The Hivoshi campus was opened in 1934 as the site for General Education courses. There are more than 11,000 students attending classes at the Hiyoshi campus.
