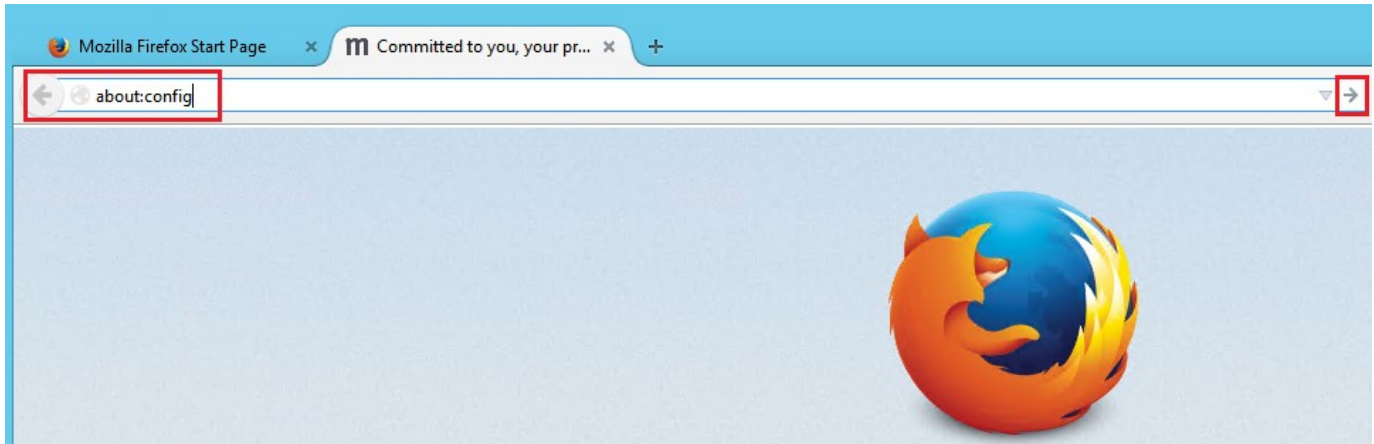




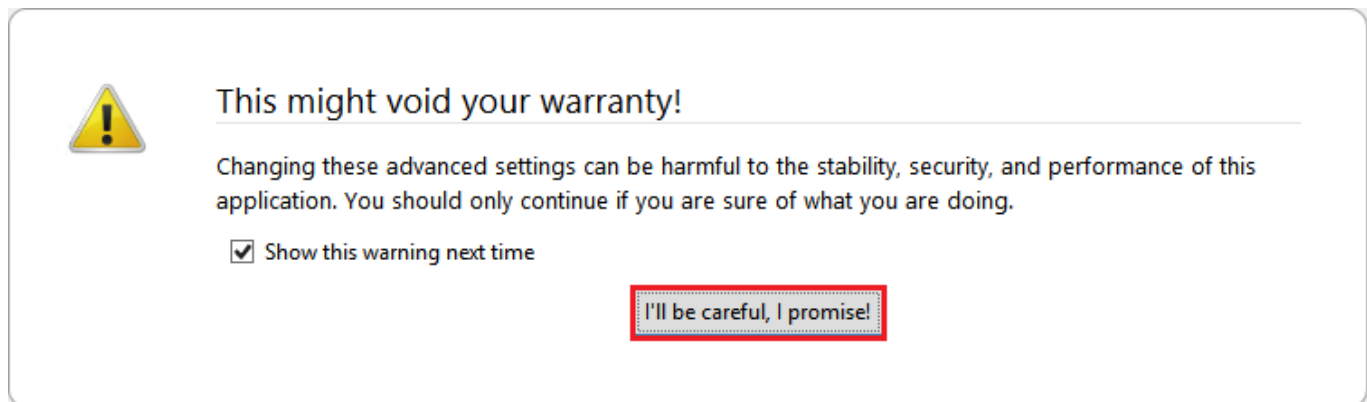
## Disable SSL in Firefox

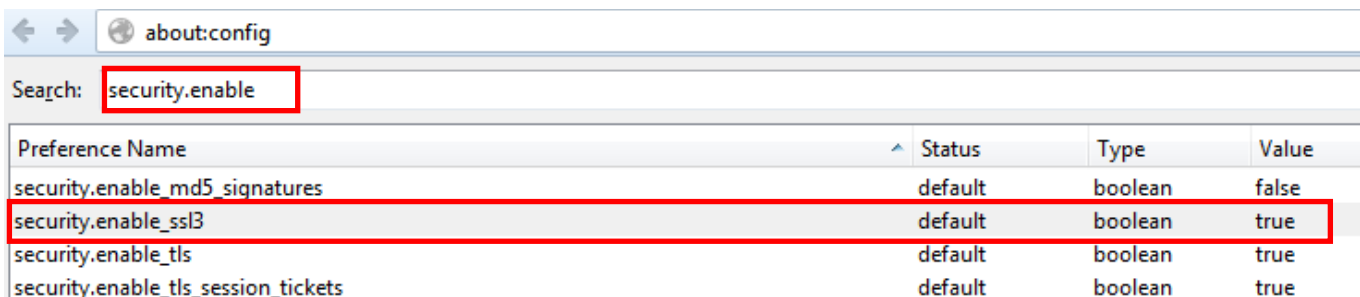
1) Open Firefox and enter *about:config* in the **Location Bar**. Press the **Enter** key or click the **Go Arrow**.



2) When you receive the “**This might void your warranty**” message, click **I'll be careful, I promise!**.



3) On the **about:config** page, in the **Search** box, enter **security.enable**. Double click the **security.enable\_ssl3** option. This will toggle the **security.enable\_ssl3** option to false.
