

Recreation/Sport Management Curriculum Changes

Recreation/Sport Management is a Major which has two concentrations; 1) Sport Management, 2) Recreation Management.

Some of the requested curriculum changes will effect both concentrations, some will affect only one.

Purpose of the Changes

Reasons for the requested changes:

1. Overall change. Changes to the curriculum codes must be made to the Recreation/Sport Management major due to the confusion that occurred when we changed the major from Recreation to Recreation/Sport Management.

The coding changes accomplishes the following:

- o All classes will be coded RCSJ or RCMJ that means that they are only open to Recreation/Sport Management Majors (you must have permission from Faculty in the department and/or have gone through advising at CEHD).
 - o All pre-requisites will be dropped from all the classes because primarily Recreation/Sport Management is a discovery major. Pre-requisites become an advising function. This means that we as a faculty and advisors can be more flexible in allowing students to take courses out of order.
2. The Recreation/Sport Management Major has now been a major for one entire academic year. We realized that we would have to make some tweaks after one year. After meeting with CEHD Advisors, and groups of students we have decided that the class tweaks will consist of:

In both Concentrations:

- ❖ COM 2000 and ECON 2020 will be removed as required Cognate Courses.
- ❖ COM 1000 and GEOG 2440 will replace those classes as required Cognates
- ❖ COM 1040 which is listed as an either/or with COM 1000 will be moved to the electives

In the Sport Management Concentration

- All students who chose the sport management concentration were required to minor in General Business. Students who are pursuing sport management wanted options in other careers such as Sports Information, Social Media/Sport Directors, etc. In addition, several people in sport information wanted a career in Event Management and Coaching. Thus, we decided to broaden the Minor Options to Communications, Coaching, and Event Management.

- In the Sport Management Concentration many of the classes are service-learning based. Thus, students are given the opportunity to spend many hours in the field working with professionals. As such, the HPHE 3990 Practicum which requires 200 hours of work with professionals is unnecessary. Thus the HPHE 3990 Practicum will be dropped in this concentration and replaced with a new course in Sport Media/Communication (HPHE 3980)
